## FEDERAL AID ROADS (NEW AGREEMENT AUTHORISATION)

AN ACT to amend the Schedule to the Federal Aid Roads (New Agreement Authorisation) Act, 1936, and for other purposes relating thereto.

[Assented to 13th September, 1937.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Federal Aid Roads (New Agreement Authorisation) Act Amendment Act, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Federal Aid Roads (New Agreement Authorisation) Act, 1936 (No. 33 of 1936), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

- The form of agreement contained in the Schedule to Amendment of Schedule. the principal Act is amended by deleting the whole of clauses four and five and inserting in lieu thereof new clauses as follow:-
  - (1.) All moneys paid to the State from the sums provided under subclause (1) of clause 2 of this agreement shall be expended upon the construction, reconstruction, maintenance, or repair of roads.
  - (2.) All moneys paid to the State from the sums provided under subclause (2) of clause 2 of this agreement shall be expended upon the construction, reconstruction, maintenance, or repair of roads or other works connected with transport, as the State may think fit.
  - 5. (1.) Whenever so required by the Minister, the State during the period of ten years commencing on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, and not thereafter will, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Minister, make provision for the proper maintenance and repair, to a standard necessary to meet the requirements of the Commonwealth and other traffic using such roads. of public roads adjoining, or of approach to, properties of the Commonwealth within the State.
  - (2.) The State shall not be required to make any provision under this clause—
    - (a) in any year in excess of an amount equivalent to one-twelfth of the moneys paid to the State in that year from the sums provided under subclause (2) of clause 2 of this agreement; or
    - (b) with respect to roads within the boundaries of the properties of the Commonwealth.
  - (3.) In this clause "properties of the Commonwealth" includes establishments, works, and activities of the Commonwealth.
- 3. The provisions of section two of this Act shall have Retrospective effect and shall be deemed to have had effect as from and specific of this specific sp including the date of the commencement of the principal Act, and the Honourable the Premier of the State shall be deemed as from and including the said date to have been duly authorised for and on behalf of the State to execute an agreement in the form contained in the

Schedule to the principal Act as amended by the provisions of section two of this Act, as if the form of agreement as amended by the provisions of section two of this Act had originally been contained in the Schedule to the principal Act.

Citation of principal Act as amended. 4. The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Federal Aid Roads (New Agreement Authorisation) Act, 1936-1937.
