AN ACT to continue the operation of the Forests Act Amendment Act, 1935.

[Assented to 8th December, 1937.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Forests Act Amendment Continuance Act, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Forests Act Amendment Act, 1935 (No. 9 of 1935), hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Operation and duration of principal Act. 2. (1.) The principal Act shall continue in operation until the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, and no longer.

Amendment of s. 3.

(2.) Section three of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words "thirty-seven" and inserting in lieu thereof the words "thirty-eight."
