FREMANTLE (SKINNER STREET) DISUSED CEMETERY.

No. 5 of 1935.

AN ACT to amend the Fremantle (Skinner street) Disused Cemetery Amendment Act, 1931.

[Assented to 5th October, 1935.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Fremantle (Skinner street) Disused Cemetery Amendment Act, 1935*, and shall be read as one with the *Fremantle (Skinner street) Disused Cemetery Amendment Act, 1931* (No. 15 of 1931), hereinafter called "the principal Act."

Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the principal Act to the contrary the Governor, on being satisfied that all slabs and tombstones have been removed and re-erected in accordance with the provisions relating to such removal and re-erection contained in section three of the principal Act, may by proclamation declare that the lands vested in the city of Fremantle by section two of the principal Act shall thenceforth be freed and discharged from all trusts affecting the same, to the intent that the same shall thereby be created and thenceforth used as a class A reserve for the purpose of public recreation, in the same way as if it had been duly classified as such under section thirty-one of the Land Act, 1933.

Skinner street cemetery may be vested in city of Fremantle without necessity of opening graves.
