AN ACT to amend the Workers' Homes Act, 1911.

[Assented to 25th November, 1935.]

B E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

This Act may be cited as the Workers' Homes Amendment Act, 1935 (No. 2), and shall be read as one with the Workers' Homes Act, 1911, and its amendments, hereinafter called the principal Act.

Amendment of s. 11, principal

2. Section eleven of the principal Act, as amended by Acts Nos. 75 of 1912, 1 of 1922, and 35 of 1928 is hereby further amended by adding a second proviso, as follows:-Provided also that the applicant may at any time pay off the whole of the moneys outstanding in respect of the capital cost of the dwelling and any accrued interest thereon and a sum equal to the last appraised value of the land on which such dwelling-house is erected and he shall be thereupon entitled to acquire the freehold of the land.
