# KING'S PARK AND UNIVERSITY LAND EXCHANGE. 

$25^{\circ}$ Geo. V., No. XLVIIII.

AN ACT to authorise an exchange of certain Land in reserve A1720 (King's Park) for certain Land comprised in Swan location 3087 and held by the University of Western Australia and for other purposes relating to the said reserve.
[Assented to 21st January, 1935.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the University of Western Australia is the registered proprietor of certain land, being Swan location 3087, adjacent to reserve A1T20 (King's Park) : And whereas it is deemed clesirable to improve and widen that part of Winthrop avenue which adjoins reserve A 1720 (King's Park), and for that purpose it is necessary that certain portions of the land in the said reserve be excised therefrom; and whereas the said Cniversity desires a certain portion of the land comprised in the said reserve for Cniversity purposes, and, in consideration of such portion being excised from the said reserve and rested in the Universitr, has offered in exchange portion of its said land in Swan location 3087 aforesaid: And whereas it is deemed desirable and experient that such exchange should be effected: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majestr, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Comeil and Legislative Assemily of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and br the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the King's Park and University Land Exchange Act, 1934.
2. Subject as hereinafter provided, those portions of reserve A1720 (King's Park) described in Parts I., II., and III. of the First Schedule hereto are hereby excised from the said reserve, and are dealt with as follows:-
(a) the land described in Part I. of the First Schedule hereto shall be and is hereby vested for an estate in fee simple in the University of Western Australia; and
(b) the lands described in Part II. and Part III. respectively of the said First Schedule shall be and are hereby rested for an estate in fee simple in the city of Perth for the purpose of additions to Winthrop avenue aforesaid.
Provided that this section shall not take effect until the University of Western Australia shall have made to His Majesty the transfer and surrender of the land described in the Second Schedule to this Act.
3. The University of Western Australia is herebr authorised to transfer and surrender to His Majesty that portion of Swan location 3087, which belongs to the said University and which is described in the Second Schedule hereto.
4. When the University of Western Australia has transferred and surrendered to His Majesty the land described in the Second Schedule hereto, such land shall be included in

The University authorised to transier land to His Majesty. and form part of reserve A1720 (King's Park).

## FIRST SCHEDULE.

## Part $I$.

All that portion of land, being part of reserve A1720 (King's Park) bounded by lines starting from a point on the northern alignment of the Perth-Fremantle road and situate $7 \overline{5 d e g}$. 19 min .1 chain $54-7 / 10$ links from the junction of the eastern aligmment of Winthrop avenue with the said northern aligment of Perth-Fremantle road, and extending 359 deg . 32 min . 9 chains $18-1 / 10$ links to the southern alignment of Park road; thence along said southern alignment 75 deg . 25 min . 67-1/10 links; thence 165 deg . 8 min . 8 chains $89-8 / 10$ links to the northern alignment of Perth-Fremantle road aforesaid, and thence along said northern alignment 255 deg . 19 min .2 chains $95-4 / 10$ links to the starting point.

## PART II.

All that portion of land, being part of reserve A.1720 (King's Park) bounded by lines starting from the junction of the eastern alignment of Winthrop avenue with the northern alignment of the Perth-Fremantle road, and extending 359 deg . 32 min . 1 chain $54-7 / 10$ links to the tangent point of a circular curve, the bearing and distance of the radius whereof is 89 deg . 32 min . 1 chain 20-4/10 links from said tangent point; thence by said curve south-easterly 2 chains 19 links to the tangent point situate on the northern alignment of Pexth-Fremantle road aforesaid, and thence 255 deg . 18 min . 1 chain $54-\overline{7} / 10$ links to the starting point.

## PART III.

All that portion of land, being part of reserve A1720 (King's Park) bownded by lines starting from the intersection of the eastern alignment of Winthrop avenue with the southern alignment of Park road, and extending 75 deg. 25 min . 1 chain $54-7 / 10$ links to the tangent point of a circular curve, the bearing and distance of the radius whereof is 165 deg . 25 min .1 chain 98-3 10 links from said tangent point; thence by said curve south-westerly 2 chains $62-7 / 10$ links to the tangent point situate on the eastern alignment of Winthrop avenue aforesaid; and thence 359 deg . 32 min . 1 chain $54-7 / 10$ links to the starting point.

All bearings being true or thereabouts and measurements more or less. Plan-Crawley.

## SECOND SCHEDULE.

All that portion of land, being part of Swan location 3087 bounded by lines starting from the junction of the southern aligmment of Park road with the western alignment of Winthrop avenne, and extending 179deg. 34min. along the latter alignment 9 chains $37-9,70$ links to the northern alignment of Stirling highway; thence 255 deg .20 min . 1 chain $93-2 / 10$ links to the tangent point of a circular carre, the bearing and distance of the radius whereof is 345 deg . 20 min . 2 chains $48-3 / 10$ links from said tangent point; thence by said curve east-north-easterly $39-\frac{1}{4} 10$ links; thence 359 deg . 34 min . 9 chains $10-3 / 10$ links to the southern alignment of Park road aforesaid, and thence 66 deg . 59 min . 1 chain $62-5 / 10$ links to the starting point.

All bearings being true or thereabouts and measurements more or less. Plan-Crawley.
