AN ACT to amend section four of the Entertainments Tax Act. 1925.

[Assented to 22nd December, 1930.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

This Act may be cited as the Entertainments Tax Act short title and Amendment Act, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Entertainments Tax Act, 1925, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, and shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by proclamation.
