No. 13 of 1928.

AN ACT to continue the operation of Section forty-one of the Forests Act, 1918, as amended by the Forests Act Amendment Acts, 1924 and 1927.

[Assented to 10th December, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Forests Act Amendment Act*, 1928, and shall be read as one with the Forests Act, 1918, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Continuation of
No. 31 of 1924.

2. Section forty-one of the principal Act shall, as from the 1st day of July, 1928, continue in force as amended by the Forests Act Amendment Acts, 1924 and 1927, and this Act until the thirtieth day of June, 1929, and no longer.
