AN ACT to amend Section Thirty-one of the Navigation Act, 1904.

[Assented to 15th November, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Navigation Act Amendment Act, 1928.* Short title.

2. Section thirty-one of the Navigation Act, 1904 (inserted by section four of the Navigation Act Amendment Act, 1926), is hereby amended by inserting after the words "Provided that," in subsection (1) thereof, the following words:—

"at the port of Fremantle, the surveyor shall be a person appointed by the Governor under section fourteen of this Act: Provided also that."
