## AN ACT to amend subsection three of section seven, and section thirteen of the Poor Persons Legal Assistance Act, 1928.

[Assented to 3rd November, 1931.]

**D**<sup>E</sup> it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Poor Persons Legal short title. Assistance Act Amendment Act, 1931, and shall be read as one with the Poor Persons Legal Assistance Act, 1928, hereinafter called "the principal Act."

2. Subsection three of section seven of the principal Act Amendment of s.s. is hereby repealed, and the following subsection is substi- (3) of s. 7 of printuted therefor:----

(3.) The public solicitor or practitioner, or, if they are unable or unwilling to act, another practitioner approved by the Minister, shall act for and conduct the case of the applicant until the same is finally disposed of.

3. Section thirteen of the principal Act is amended by Amendment of B. excising the words "and any costs which an unsuccessful poor person receiving legal assistance under this Act is liable to pay the opposite party" in the eighth, ninth, and tenth lines of that section.
