AN ACT to prohibit Racing by and between Animals other than Horses.

[Assented to 30th November, 1927.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Bill may be cited as the Racing Restriction Act, 1927.

Prohibition of racing where mechanical devices, etc., used.

2. The use of any mechanical device or contrivance for the promotion of or in connection with racing by or between animals other than horses, at or in any place to which the public is admitted on payment or otherwise, is unlawful.

Penalty, Five hundred pounds.

Penalty for taking part in unlawful racing. 3. Any person who promotes, engages in, or takes part in any racing declared to be unlawful by section two of this Act, shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty, One hundred pounds.
