AN ACT to amend section three of the Totalisator Duty Act, 1905.

[Assented to 19th December, 1930.]

B it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Totalisator Duty Act* Amendment Act, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Totalisator Duty Act, 1905, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

- 2. Section three of the principal Act (as amended by section three of the Totalisator Duty Act Amendment Act, 1918) is amended—
  - (a) by substituting the words "seven and one-half" for the word "six" in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) of subsection one:
  - (b) by substituting the words "thirteen and one-half" for the words "twelve and one-half" in subsection three.
