AN ACT to amend Section 44b of the Workers' Homes Act, 1911-1928.

[Assented to 15th April, 1929.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

- This Act may be cited as the Workers' Homes Act short title. Amendment Act, 1929.
- The words "or for the purpose of enlarging a dwelling- Amendment of house of which he is the owner" in paragraph (4) of section 44b of the Workers' Homes Act, 1911-1928, are hereby transposed to paragraph (3) thereof, and are inserted therein to follow the words "of discharging a mortgage upon one dwelling-house of which he is the owner" in the said paragraph (3), and the words "which advances the Board, as a State authority, is hereby authorised to accept, under and subject to the provisions of that Act," are inserted in the third line of the said section 44b, between the figures "1928" and the word "may."
