AN ACT to amend the Kalgoorlie and Boulder Racing Clubs Act, 1904.

[Assented to 7th October, 1926.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

- This Act may be cited as the Kalgoorlie and Boulder short stile. Racing Clubs Act Amendment Act, 1926, and shall be read as one with the Kalgoorlie and Boulder Racing Clubs Act, 1904, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.
- 2. Section twenty-six of the principal Act is amended by Amendment of inserting after the word "club," in line twelve thereof, the sec. 26. words "or for the purpose of maintaining and controlling the said racecourses, and carrying on racing thereon, and providing stakes or prize-money, and for other purposes incidental thereto."
