

INDUSTRIES ASSISTANCE.

AN ACT to amend and continue the operation of the Industries Assistance Act, 1915.

[Assented to 22nd February, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Industries Assistance Act Continuance Act, 1922*, and shall be read as one with the Industries Assistance Act, 1915, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, and its amendments. Short title.

2. Section fifteen of the Industries Assistance Act Amendment Act, 1917, as amended by the Industries Assistance Act Continuance Act, 1921, is hereby further amended by omitting the figures "1923," and inserting the figures "1924" in place thereof. Continuance of principal Act.
