AN ACT to amend the Road Districts Act, 1919.

[Assented to 22nd February, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Road Districts Act Amendment Act, 1923*, and shall be read as one with the Road Districts Act, 1919, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section two hundred and thirty-three of the principal Act is amended, as follows:— Amendment of section 233.

(1.) By adding to paragraph (a) of subsection (2) the following words:—“Provided also that in any district in which not less than three-fourths in area of all rateable

land is held for pastoral purposes only, the rate may, in the discretion of the Board, be reduced to not less than one halfpenny in the pound.

(2.) By inserting, at the commencement of subsection (3), the words "Subject as aforesaid."

3. All copies of the principal Act to be hereafter printed by the Government Printer shall be printed as amended by this Act, under the superintendence of the Clerk of the Parliaments, and a reference to this Act shall be made in the margin.
