Issue and application of £2,150,000.

E, Your Majesty's Most Dutiful and Loyal Subjects, the Members of the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia in Parliament assembled, towards making good the supply which we have cheerfully granted to Your Majesty in this Session of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the sum hereinafter mentioned, and do, therefore, most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be enacted: And be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and

assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply granted to Hig Majorty

consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament

1. There shall and may be issued and applied for or towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the service of the year from 1st July, 1924, to 30th June,

1925, the Sum of One Million Three Hundred thousand Pounds out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, and from Moneys to Credit of the General Loan Fund Eight Hundred and Forty-four Thousand Pounds; and from Moneys to Credit of the Government Property Sales Fund Five Thousand Pounds; and from Moneys to credit of the Land Improvement Loan Fund One Thousand Pounds; and the Treasurer of Western Australia is hereby authorised and empowered to issue and apply the Moneys authorised to Le issued and applied.

The said sums shall be available to satisfy the warrants sums available for under the hand of the Governor, under the provisions of the he Legislative the Legislative law now in force, in respect of any Services voted by the Legislative Assembly during the financial year ending 30th June, 1925, or issued for such purposes.
