

## ROADS CLOSURE.

16° GEO. V., No. XXXVIII.

No. 38 of 1925.

**AN ACT for the Closure of portions of certain Roads and Ways and for other relevant purposes.**

[Assented to 31st December, 1925.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Roads Closure Act, 1925.*

Closure of portion  
of Clifton Street,  
Perth.

2. That portion of Clifton Street in the City of Perth bounded by lines starting at the South corner of Perth Lot Y288, and extending  $28^{\circ} 17' 4$  chains 51.1 links; thence  $73^{\circ} 17' 70.7$  links; thence  $208^{\circ} 17' 5$  chains 1 link; and thence  $298^{\circ} 14' 50$  links to the starting point, is closed, and all rights of way over the same shall cease on the passing of this Act.

Closure of portion  
of Ocean Parade,  
North Fremantle.

3. That portion of Ocean Parade in the Municipality of North Fremantle lying between the production Westward of the Southern side of John Street, and the North-Eastern boundary of North Fremantle Lot 209 and its production North-Westward, is closed, and all rights of way over the same shall cease on the passing of this Act: Provided that a deviation of Ocean Parade in lieu thereof shall be provided to the Westward two chains in width.

4. That portion of the street in the Narrogin Municipality bounded on the West by the Eastern boundary of Lot 2F, on the South by the Easterly production of the Southern boundary of the said Lot, and on the North-East by part of the South-Western boundary of the Railway Station Reserve, is closed, and all rights of way over the same shall cease on the passing of this Act; and such portion of the said street may be granted in fee simple to the Council of the said Municipality.

Closure of portion of a street in Narrogin.

5. That portion of East Railway Street in the Cottesloe Municipality bounded by lines starting at an angle post on the South-Eastern boundary of the Perth-Fremantle Railway Reserve, the said post being situated North about 60 links and West about 1 chain 93 links from the West corner of Cottesloe Suburban Lot 100, and extending  $19^{\circ} 35' 13.2$  links: thence  $89^{\circ} 20' 70.8$  links; thence  $179^{\circ} 25' 67$  links; thence  $268^{\circ} 29' 96.1$  links and  $19^{\circ} 45' 59.7$  links to the starting point, is closed, and all rights of way over the same shall cease on the passing of this Act.

Closure of portion of East Railway Street, Cottesloe.

6. (1) That portion of Richmond Crescent in the East Fremantle Municipality lying between the production Westward of the South side of Bolton Street and the North side of Surbiton Road, is hereby closed, and all rights of way over the same shall cease on the passing of this Act.

Closure of portion of Richmond Crescent, East Fremantle.

(2) It shall be lawful for the Council of the said Municipality to extend Angwin Street from Surbiton Road to Bolton Street by proclaiming a road, notwithstanding that the width thereof is under 66 feet.

7. The way over those portions of North Fremantle Town Lots 43, 46, 47, 49, and 50 delineated and coloured brown and marked "Right-of-way" on Deposited Plan No. 1593 in the Office of Land Titles is hereby closed, and all rights of way over the same shall cease on the passing of this Act.

Closure of a way in the North Fremantle Municipality.

8. The Governor may, by proclamation, declare that that portion of Barker Street, in the Municipality of North Fremantle, lying between North Fremantle Lots 40 and 41 from Bracks Street to Ocean Parade, shall be closed, and thereupon all rights of way over same shall cease, and the soil thereof shall by virtue of such proclamation be revested in His Majesty.
