AN ACT to enable Victoria Location 1229 to be granted in fee simple to the Trustees of the Victoria District Turf Club in lieu of an existing lease, with power to sell, subject to the proceeds being applied to the improvement of Reserves $_{\Lambda}18098$ and $_{\Lambda}16855$, and to authorise a lease of portion of Reserve $_{\Lambda}16855$ to the said Trustees.

B E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Geraldton Racecourse Act, short title. 1922.

[1922.

Power to grant Victoria Location 1229 to Trustees, with right to sell and apply proceeds to the improvement of Reserves Λ 18098 and Λ 16855. 2. (1.) Victoria Location 1229, as now held under lease to the Trustees of the Victoria Turf Club for a term of 999 years, is hereby revested in His Majesty as of his former estate; and it shall be lawful for the Governor, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, to grant the said land to the Trustees of the Victoria District Turf Club for an estate in fee simple.

(2.) The grantees may, with the approval of the Governor, sell the land to be so granted for an estate in fee simple, subject to the proceeds of sale being applied, to the satisfaction of the Minister for Lands, to the improvement of Reserves $\uparrow 18098$ and $\uparrow 16855$.

Power to lease portion of ∧16885. 3. The Victoria District Agricultural Society may, with the approval of the Governor, lease portion of Reserve \uparrow 16885 to the Trustees of the Victoria District Turf Club for a term not exceeding fifty years, and under and subject to such conditions as the Governor may think fit.
