AN ACT to amend the Licensing Act, 1911.

[Assented to 31st January, 1922.]

B E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

short title.

Granting of new licenses suspended.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Licensing Act Amendment Act*, 1922, and shall be read as one with the Licensing Act, 1911.

2. It shall be unlawful, during the continuance of this Act, for a Licensing Court to grant any license or to register any club for or in respect of premises not licensed or registered at the commencement of this Act:

Provided that this section shall not apply to eatinghouse, boarding-house, or lodging-house licenses, billiard table licenses, or occasional licenses, or to licenses issued under section forty-five of the principal Act, or to club registrations already promised by a Licensing Bench.

Goldfields District and North-West District exempt, **3.** The provisions of this Act shall not apply to the Goldfields District or the North-West District as defined by the Sale of Liquor Regulation Act, 1915.

Duration of Act.

4. This Act shall continue in force until the 31st day of December, 1922, and no longer.
