AN ACT to amend the Light and Air Act, 1902.

[Assented to 30th November, 1922.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Light and Air Act Amendment Act, 1922*, and shall be read as one with the Light and Air Act, 1902, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Amendment of
Section 2.

2. The second proviso to section two of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "and no longer," in paragraph (b), and inserting in place thereof the follow-

ing words:—"or, with the approval in writing of the Governor (but not otherwise), for a term exceeding twenty-one years"; and a paragraph is added to the said section, as follows:—

But no such grant shall have effect or be enforced so as to prevent the erection of any building on the alignment of a street to a depth of twelve feet.

3. All copies of the principal Act to be printed hereafter by the Government Printer shall be printed as amended by this Act, under the supervision of the Clerk of Parliaments.
