AN ACT to amend the Navigation Act, 1904.

[Assented to 31st December, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Navigation Act Amendment Act, 1920*, and shall be read as one with the Navigation Act, 1904, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. Section three of the principal Act is hereby repealed, and a section is inserted in its place as follows :— Amendment of section 3.

3. This Act shall not apply to ships belonging to the King's Navy or to the navy of the Commonwealth or of any British possession, or the navy of any foreign Government. Exemptions. Com. No. 4 of 1913, s. 3.
