AN ACT to amend the Nurses Registration Act, 1921.

[Assented to 30th November, 1922.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Nurses Registration Amendment Act, 1922*, and shall be read as one with the Nurses Registration Act, 1921, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

Amendment of
Section 5.

2. Section five of the principal Act is amended, as follows:—

(a) In subsection (1) the words “the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-two,” are omitted, and the words and figures “the 1st day of July, 1923, are inserted in place thereof.

(b) In subsection (4) the words “an authority outside the State” are omitted, and the words “the Australian Trained Nurses’ Association, the Royal Victorian Trained Nurses’ Association, the Royal British Nurses’ Association, or other association or authority outside the State recognised by the Board” are inserted in place thereof.

Reprinting of
principal Act.

3. All copies of the principal Act hereafter printed by the Government Printer shall be printed, under the superintendence of the Clerk of Parliaments, as amended by this Act.
