### No. 1 of 1921.

#### AN ACT to make further provision for the signing of Treasury Bills.

[Assented to 28th July, 1921.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Treasury Bills (Signatures) Act, 1921.* Short title.

2. Treasury Bills bearing the signatures of the Agent General and the Accountant at the London Agency, in lieu of the signatures of the Colonial Treasurer and the Under Treasurer, may be lawfully made out and issued in London under the authority of the Treasury Bills Act, 1893 (the Act No. 2 of the 57th year of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria), the Treasury Bills Act Amendment Act, 1897, and the Treasury Bills Act Amendment Act, 1916, for the purpose of raising a sum of money not exceeding Two million pounds; and shall be registered in the Treasury and by the Auditor General on the receipt by the Colonial Treasurer of advice from the Agent General of the issue thereof.
