AN ACT to further amend the Stamp Act, 1882.

[Assented to 10th February, 1915.]

B E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- This Act may be cited as the Stamp Act Amendment Act, Short title. 1914, and shall be read as one with the Stamp Act, 1882, and the Acts amending the same.
- 2. No instrument by the Stamp Act, 1882, or any Act amend- Public Officer not ing the same made liable to any stamp duty shall be received, to receive any unstamped instruregistered, recorded, or enrolled by any public officer unless such ment. instrument is duly stamped.

3. The schedule to the Stamp Act Amendment Act, 1913, is Amendment of amended by omitting the words "mortgagee or obligee," in the No. 29 of 1913. eighth and ninth lines of the column headed "Person liable to penalty," and inserting in place thereof "mortgagor or obligor."

4. Where there are several instruments of collateral security Collateral for the same moneys as are secured by a primary security duly stamped, only one of such instruments shall be liable to stamp duty as a collateral security.
