AN ACT to authorise the application of Money collected for the erection of a Cottage Hospital at Donnybrook to the provision of a Memorial to Soldiers coming from the Preston Road District.

Presmble.

WHEREAS certain funds have been raised by the subscription of various persons for the erection of a Cottage Hospital at Donnybrook, and it is desirable that such funds should be applied to or towards the provision of a suitable memorial to those soldiers coming from the Pres-

ton Road District who have lost or shall lose their lives in the present War, and this cannot be done without the authority of Parliament: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

The said funds shall be applied by the said trustees, subject to the directions of the Preston Road District Soldiers' Memorial Committee, to or towards the provision of a suitable memorial to those soldiers coming from the Preston Road District who have lost or shall lose their lives in the present War.

Application of funds.

4. A certificate of the Colonial Secretary published in the Evidence of Gazette that any persons are or constitute the trustees or Trustees and committee aforesaid shall be conclusive evidence of the fact Committee of Memorial. for the purposes of this Act.
