AN ACT to empower the Government to establish and delimit, by Proclamation, Ports and Harbours for the purposes of Ordinances 18 Victoriæ, No. 15, and 37 Victoriæ, No. 14, and for other relative purposes.

[Assented to 23rd March, 1917.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and concent of the T with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Ports and Harbours Act, 1917. Short title.
