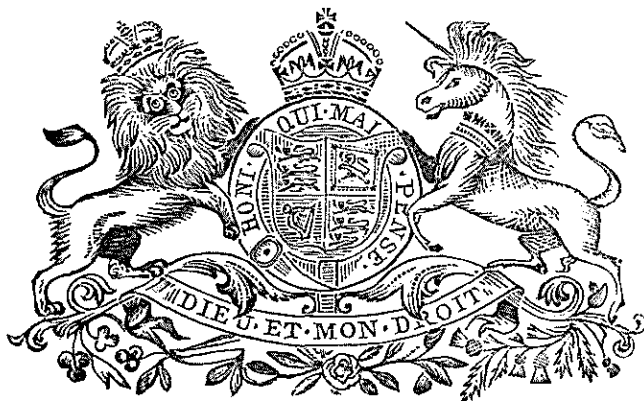

AN ACT to enable the Midland Railway Company of Western Australia to transfer a portion of Swan Location 16 for the purpose of a Trades Hall.

[Assented to 18th February, 1915.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Midland Junction Trades Hall Act, 1915.* Short title.

2. It shall be lawful for the Midland Railway Company of Western Australia to transfer a portion of Swan Location 16, containing about thirty-six perches, for the purpose of a Trades Hall. Power to transfer site.
