No. 47 of 1919.

AN ACT to authorise the raising of a sum of Three million three hundred and thirty-nine thousand pounds by Loan for the construction of certain Public Works and for other purposes, and the Re-appropriation of certain Loan moneys.

[Assented to 17th December, 1919.]

HEREAS it is expedient to authorise the rising, by Prenuble. way of Loan, of certain sums of money amounting in all to Three million three hundred and thirty-nine thousand pounds for the several purposes hereinafter mentioned, and also to re-appropriate certain Loan moneys : Be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same. as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited for all purposes as the Loan short title. Act, 1919.

2. It shall be lawful for the Governor, from time to Power to raise time, to raise by way of loan such several sums of money, certain purnot exceeding in the whole the sum of Three million three hundred and thirty-nine thousand pounds, as may be required for the several works and purposes mentioned in the First Schedule to this Act.

3. All sums by this Act authorised to be raised shall be sums raised, how to be applied. to the credit of an account to be called the General Loan

Fund, and shall be applied by the Colonial Treasurer to the purposes set forth in this Act, in such amounts and manner as the Governor by any warrants under his hand may from time to time authorise and direct, in conformity with the annual Estimates of the expenditure of Loan moneys sanctioned by Parliament.

4. The principal moneys, and interest thereon, raised under the authority of this Act shall rank *pari passu* with the principal moneys and interest raised and secured by the Stock created and sold under the Loan Act, 1891, and all subsequent Loan Acts, and are hereby charged upon and shall be payable out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and Assets of the Government of Western Australia, and shall constitute a charge thereon, subject to the prior charges mentioned in the fourth section of the Loan Act, 1891.

> 5. The Governor may, from time to time, by warrant under his hand, authorise the Colonial Treasurer to advance and apply to the purposes set forth in the First Schedule of this Act any sums of money not exceeding in the whole the sum hereby authorised to be raised; and any sums of money so advanced and paid shall be retained by the Colonial Treasurer out of any moneys coming to his hands under the authority of this Act.

Re-appropriation from and to. 6. It shall further be lawful for the Governor to appropriate out of the sums set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, from the items therein set forth, and to the items enumerated in the Third Schedule hereto, the sum of Eighty-five thousand five hundred pounds to be expended on the works named in the Third Schedule hereto.
