

LICENSING—AMENDMENT.

No. 38 of 1918.

AN ACT to continue the operation of the Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1914.

[Assented to 24th December, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Licensing Act Amendment Continuance Act*, 1918. Short title.

2. The Licensing Act Amendment Act, 1914, is hereby revived, and shall continue in force and effect until the thirty-first day of December, One thousand nine hundred and nineteen, and no longer. Continuance of Act No. 22 of 1914.
