AN ACT to further amend and continue the operation of the Industries Assistance Act, 1915.

[Assented to 3rd January, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- Short title.
- 1. This Act may be cited as the *Industries Assistance Act Amendment Act*, 1918.
- Continuation of principal Act.
- 2. Section fifteen of the Industries Assistance Act Amendment Act, 1917, as amended by the Industries Assistance Act Continuation Act, 1918, is hereby further amended by omitting the figures "1919," and inserting the figures "1920" in place thereof.
- Report and balance-sheet to be presented to Parliament.
- 3. A report and balance sheet of the operations of the Board shall be laid before both Houses of Parliament, by the Minister in charge of the Department, on or before the thirtieth day of September, 1919.
