AN ACT to further amend the Fremantle
Harbour Trust Act, 1902.

[Assented to 4th October, 1913.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Fremantle Harbour Trust Amendment Act*, 1913, and shall be read as one with the Fremantle Harbour Trust Act, 1902, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. The Commissioners may give, by bond or otherwise, such security as the Customs may require under the provisions of the Customs Act, 1901. Security to Customs.

3. In all copies of the principal Act hereafter printed by the Government Printer, section two of this Act shall be inserted and numbered eighty-eight, under the supervision of the Clerk of the Parliaments, and a reference to this Act shall be made in the margin. Reprint of principal Act.
