AN ACT to amend the Employment Brokers Act, 1909.

[Assented to 23rd May, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Employment Brokers Act Amendment Act, 1918*, and shall be read as one with the Employment Brokers Act, 1909, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. A paragraph is added to section fifteen of the principal Act as follows :— Amendment of Section 15 of No 57 of 1909.

“No payment or remuneration for or in respect of any hiring shall be charged by an employment broker to the servant which is not equally charged to the employer.”

Manner of showing  
amendments.

3. All copies of the principal Act to be hereafter printed by the Government Printer shall be printed as amended by this Act, under the supervision of the Clerk of Parliaments.
