

AN ACT to authorise the Construction, Maintenance, and Working of a Siding connected with the Eastern Railway at East Perth.

[Assented to 22nd September, 1914.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. It shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Railways to construct, maintain, and work as a railway a siding connected with the Eastern Railway, at East Perth, as described in the Schedule hereto.

THE SCHEDULE

A siding of 3ft. 6in. gauge commencing at a point in East Perth Station Yard on the Eastern Railway, and proceeding thence via Sampson Street and crossing Claisebrook Road to Kensington Street; thence via Kensington Street crossing Jewell Street to the Eastern boundary of Trafalgar Road; in length 45½ chains, or thereabouts; as more particularly delineated and coloured red on copy of E.E.L. Plan No. 15,496.
