

AN ACT to further amend the Constitution Act, 1889.

[Assented to 16th February, 1911.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Constitution Act Amendment* Act, 1911.

2. Section fiftcen of the Constitution Acts Amendment Act, Amendment of 63 Viet., No. 19, s. 15. 1899, is amended as follows:---

- (a.) By omitting the words "one hundred" in subsection oneand inserting "fifty" in place thereof;
- (b.) By omitting the words "twenty-five" in subsections two, three, five, and six, and inserting the word "seventeen," in place thereof, in each of the said subsections.
