AN ACT to appropriate and apply out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund and from Moneys to Credit of the Trust Fund and the General Loan Fund certain sums to make good the supplies granted for the Service of the Year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirteen, and to supplement grants made by the present Parliament during its last Session in adjustment of the Vote "Advance to Treasurer, 1911-12," for charges during the Year ended the 30th day of June, 1912.

[Assented to 16th December, 1912.]

Most Gracious Sovereign,—

TE, Your Majesty's Most Dutiful and Loyal Subjects, the Preamble Legislative Asssembly of Western Australia, in Parliament assembled, towards making good the Supply which we have cheerfully granted to your Majesty in this Session of Parliament, have resolved to grant unto Your Majesty the Sums hereinafter mentioned, and do therefore most humbly beseech Your Majesty that it may be

enacted: And be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows (that is to say):—

Application of Moneys.

1. There shall and may be issued and applied, for or towards making good the supply granted to His Majesty for the services of the year ending the thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and thirteen, the following sums, that is to say:

From the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of Two Million One Hundred and Eighty-three Thousand and Sixty-eight Pounds.

From moneys to credit of the Trust Fund, the sum of Fortyone Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-eight Pounds.

From moneys to credit of the General Loan Fund, the sum of Three Million and Seventy-two Thousand Two Hundred and Eighty-five Pounds.

Appropriation of supplies.

Schedule A.

2. All sums granted by this Act, and the Acts mentioned in Schedule A to this Act, towards making good the Supply granted to His Majesty, that is to say:

From the Consolidated Revenue Fund, the sum of Three Million Four Hundred and Fifty-eight Thousand Two Hundred and Twenty-eight Pounds.

From moneys to credit of the Trust Fund, the sum of Fortyone Thousand Eight Hundred and Thirty-eight Pounds.

From moneys to credit of the General Loan Fund, the sum of Three Million Eight Hundred and Eighty-six Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty-seven Pounds.

From the Public Account for Advance to Treasurer the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Pounds; and

Advance to Treasurer.

3. All sums granted by this Act to supplement grants in confirmation of the expenditure from the vote, "Advance to Treasurer, 1911-12," for charges during the year ended the 30th day of June, 1912, that is to say:

From the Consolidated Revenue Fund the sum of One Hundred and Forty-two Thousand Two Hundred and Seventy-five Pounds One Shilling and Nine pence.

From the General Loan Fund the sum of Two Hundred and Thirty Thousand Three Hundred and Seventeen Pounds Nineteen Shillings and Three Pence.
