AN ACT to enable the purposes of certain
Permanent Reserves to be changed.

[Assented to 6th February, 1909.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. All those portions of permanent reserve numbered ^{AA}5691 situated in the Municipal District of Subiaco, more particularly described in the First Schedule, and now dedicated to the purpose of a school site, are hereby excised from the said reserve and included in permanent reserve number 5694^{AA} and dedicated to the purpose of municipal gardens.

2. That portion of permanent reserve numbered ^{AA}3078 situated in the Municipal District of Subiaco, more particularly described in the Second Schedule, and now dedicated to the purpose of public buildings, is hereby excised from the said reserve and included in permanent reserve number 6052^{AA} and dedicated to the purpose of a Children's Hospital site.

First Schedule.

All those portions of permanent reserve numbered AΛ5691:

1. Bounded by lines starting from the South-West corner of Perth Suburban Lot 424 and extending West 1 chain $77\frac{2}{5}$ links; thence South to the North-Western boundary of Reserve 5694; thence North-West along said boundary to the starting point.

2. Bounded by lines starting from the South-West corner of Perth Suburban Lot 437, and extending North along its Western boundary 2 chains; thence West $27\frac{2}{5}$ links; thence South 2 chains to Hamersley Road; thence East $27\frac{2}{5}$ links along Hamersley Road to the starting point.

Second Schedule.

All that portion of permanent reserve numbered AΛ3078, known as Perth Suburban Lot 466, containing one rood and twenty perches, and bounded by lines starting from the West corner of Perth Suburban Lot 463, and extending $180^{\circ} 35' 3$ chains 29 links to the North-Western side of Thomas Street; thence $222^{\circ} 48' 1$ chain $13\frac{2}{5}$ links along said side of street to the North side of Hay Street; thence $270^{\circ} 41' 20\frac{2}{5}$ links along said side of Hay Street; thence $0^{\circ} 35' 4$ chains $10\frac{2}{5}$ links to the South boundary of Perth Suburban Lot 185, and thence $90^{\circ} 36' 1$ chain to the starting point.
