

AN ACT to enable the purposes of certain Permanent Reserves to be changed.

[Assented to 6th February, 1909.]

B^E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia. in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:---

1. All those portions of permanent reserve numbered 5691 Change of purpose situated in the Municipal District of Subiaco, more particularly of portions of described in the First Schedule, and now dedicated to the purpose Reserve $\frac{\Lambda}{5691}$ of a school site, are hereby excised from the said reserve and included in permanent reserve number 5694A and dedicated to the purpose of municipal gardens.

That portion of permanent reserve numbered 3078 situated _{Change of purpose} 2. in the Municipal District of Subiaco. more particularly described in of portion of the Second Schedule, and now dedicated to the purpose of public Reserve 3078. buildings, is hereby excised from the said reserve and included in permanent reserve number 6052 and dedicated to the purpose of a Children's Hospital site.

First Schedule.

All those portions of permanent reserve numbered AA5691:

1. Bounded by lines starting from the South-West corner of Perth Suburban Lot 424 and extending West 1 chain 77_{15}^{*} links; thence South to the North-Western boundary of Reserve 5694; thence North-West along said boundary to the starting point.

2. Bounded by lines starting from the South-West corner of Perth Suburban Lot 437, and extending North along its Western boundary 2 chains; thence West $27\frac{2}{10}$ links; thence South 2 chains to Hamersley Road; thence East $27\frac{2}{10}$ links along Hamersley Road to the starting point.

Second Schedule.

All that portion of permanent reserve numbered AA3078, known as Ferth Suburban Lot 466, containing one rood and twenty perches, and bounded by lines starting from the West corner of Perth Suburban Lot 463, and extending 180° 35′ 3 chains 29 links to the North-Western side of Thomas Street; thence 222° 48′ 1 chain $13\frac{1}{10}$ links along said side of street to the North side of Hay Street; thence 270° 41′ 20 $\frac{1}{10}$ links along said side of Hay Street; thence 0° 35′ 4 chains $10\frac{1}{10}$ links to the South boundary of Perth Suburban Lot 185, and thence 90° 36′ 1 chain to the starting point.
