AN ACT to alter the Boundaries of the Midland Junction Municipal District, by including therein portion of the Swan Road District.

[Assented to 16th January, 1909.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The land described in the schedule to this Act is hereby severed from the Swan Road District and annexed to and included within the municipal district of Midland Junction, and the boundaries of the said municipal district are hereby altered accordingly.

Alteration of boundaries of Midland Junction Municipal district.

2. (1.) All rates due and payable to the Swan Road Board at the commencement of this Act in respect of the said land shall, notwithstanding this Act, be recoverable by the said board.

Apportionment of rates.

(2.) The Swan Road Board shall pay to the Municipality of Midland Junction a proportionate part of the rates received by the said Board for the year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and nine, in respect of the said land com-

puted from the passing of this Act, and the Council of the said Municipality shall apply the money so received as far as it extends in or towards payment of the municipal rates to become due and payable in respect of the said land for the financial year commencing the first day of November, one thousand nine hundred and eight.

THE SCHEDULE.

The area bounded on the Northward by the Southern side of the York Road; on the Eastward by the Western side of Helena street; on the Southward by the Northern side of the Eastern Railway Reserve; and on the West by the production North of the Eastern side of Archer Street.
