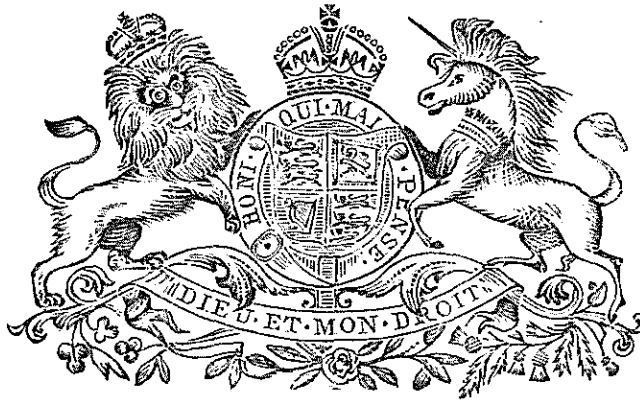

AN ACT to amend the Interpretation Act,
1898.

[Assented to 21st December, 1909.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Interpretation Act Amendment Act*, 1909. Short title.

2. Section nine of the Interpretation Act, 1898, is amended, by adding the following words:— Amendment of
62 Vict., No. 30, s. 9.

“Provided that notices required to be served by the Land and Income Tax Assessment Act, 1907, or any amendment thereof, shall be deemed to be duly served if posted in an unregistered prepaid letter.”
