AN ACT to validate the General Rates made
by the Road Board of the Road District
of Cottesloe Beach, formerly Buckland Hill.

[Assented to 21st December, 1909.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. All general rates heretofore made and levied or purporting to be made and levied by the Road Board of the Road District of Cottesloe Beach (formerly known as Buckland Hill), shall be deemed to have been lawfully made and levied, and all things necessary to be done in and towards the making and levying of such rates shall be deemed to have been duly performed notwithstanding any failure to comply with any of the provisions of the Roads Act, 1902, relating thereto, and the said rates may be recovered by the said Road Board accordingly as if the provisions of the said Act were in all respects duly complied with. Rates validated.
