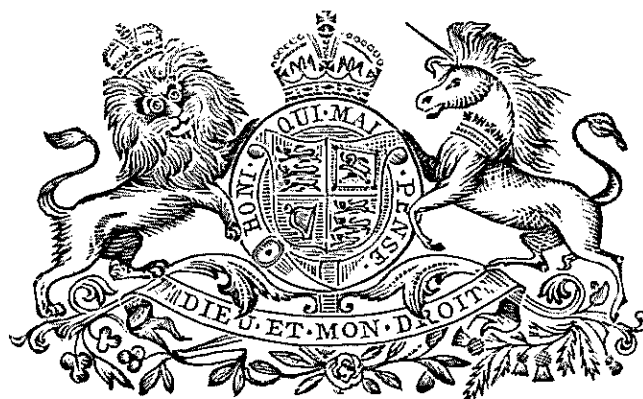

AN ACT to amend the Bills of Sale Amendment Act, 1906.

[Assented to 29th October, 1909.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Bills of Sale Act Amendment Act, 1909.* Short title.

2. Section nineteen of the Bills of Sale Amendment Act, 1906, is hereby repealed, and the said Act shall be made perpetual. and the same is hereby made perpetual.

Repeal of Section 19 of the Bills of Sale Amendment Act, 1906, and the same Act made perpetual.
