AN ACT to amend the Tramways Act, 1885.

[Assented to, 1st November, 1904.]

B it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

This Act may be cited as the Tramways Amendment Act, Short title and 1904, and shall be read as one with the Tramways Act, 1885 incorporation with 49 Vict., No. 23. (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), which, as from the commencement thereof, shall be taken to have been amended as hereinafter provided.

- Section thirty-four of the principal Act is hereby amended Amendment of sec. by inserting after the word "regulations," in the seventh line thereof, 34. the words "made under this or the last preceding section."
- Section thirty-six of the principal Act is hereby repealed, and Amendment of sec. the following shall be inserted in place thereof:—
  - The local authority shall have the like power of Power of local making and enforcing regulations and by-laws, and of granting authority to license cars, drivers, etc. licenses, with respect to all cars using the tramways, and to

all drivers, conductors, and other persons having charge of or using such cars, as the local authority is for the time being entitled to make, enforce, and grant with respect to passenger vehicles generally:

Provided that the annual license fee to be charged in respect of each car, driver, or conductor shall not exceed one shilling.

Amendment of sec. 46.

4. Section forty-six of the principal Act is hereby repealed, and the following shall be inserted in place thereof:—

Promoters may agree with local authority for composition of rates. 46. The local authority and the promoters of any tramway may, from time to time, enter into agreements for the payment by the promoters to the local authority of a composition in lieu of rates in respect of the user of roads, and in respect of all lands, buildings, or works used by the promoters for tramway purposes exclusively.
