AN ACT to amend the Navigation Act, 1904.

[Assented to 10th December, 1907.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Navigation Act Amendment Act*, Short title. 1907.

2. Section two of the Navigation Act, 1904, is hereby amended by inserting after the definition of the word "Legislature" the following: "'Machinery' includes boilers." Amendment of
