AN ACT to further amend the Metropolitan Water Works Act, 1896.

[Assented to 1st November, 1904.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Metropolitan Water Works Amendment Act, 1904*, and shall be read as one with the Metropolitan Water Works Act, 1896, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

Short title, and incorporation with 60 Vict., No. 19.

2. The Governor may, from time to time, by Order in Council, authorise and appoint the Minister for Works (hereinafter referred to as the Minister) to exercise the functions of the Board, for such time as the Governor may think fit.

Governor may appoint Minister of Works to exercise functions of Board.

On such appointment, Board superseded.

3. On the publication of such Order in Council in the *Government Gazette*, and so long as the same shall continue in force, the Board shall be superseded by the Minister, who shall have all the powers and duties of the Board, and for all the purposes of the principal Act shall be deemed to be the Board.

Salaries of members suspended during supersession.

4. The salaries payable to the members of the Board under the provisions of the principal Act shall cease to be payable during any period of supersession.
