**AN ACT to amend the Jury Act, 1898.**

*[Assented to 23rd December, 1905.]*

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Jury Amendment Act, 1905*, Short title. and shall be read as one with the Jury Act, 1898, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act.

2. The several lists of persons qualified and liable to serve on juries under the provisions of the principal Act, transmitted from the Perth, Fremantle, and Swan magisterial districts, shall be transcribed by the sheriff into one jurors' book for the several districts, which for such purpose shall be deemed to be one district; and such jurors' book shall be the jurors' book for the summoning of every jury for the trial of persons charged upon indictment or information for indictable offences, or for the trial of issues of fact in any action or proceeding in the Supreme Court, or for the assessment of damages, whether before a judge or before the sheriff, within any of the said several districts.
