AN ACT to amend the Health Act, 1898.

[Assented to 14th December, 1906.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Health Act Amendment Act*, 1906, and shall be read as one with the Health Act, 1898, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Short title.

2. (1.) Every municipal district shall be a health district within the meaning of the principal Act, and the municipal council shall be the local board of health for such district, and as such municipal council may exercise all the powers and authorities and shall be subject to all the duties and obligations conferred or imposed upon local boards of health by and under the principal Act. Municipal councils to administer Act as the local authority.

(2.) The principal Act shall, as from the commencement thereof, be deemed to have had effect as amended by this Act.
