AN ACT to enable the purpose of portion of  
Permanent Reserve numbered 8519<sup>AA</sup> to be  
changed.

[Assented to 14th December, 1905.]

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. That portion of permanent reserve numbered 8519<sup>AA</sup>, known as Broome Lot 136, containing two rods and sixteen perches, and now dedicated to the purpose of recreation, is hereby excluded from the said reserve, and is constituted permanent reserve number 9914<sup>AA</sup>, and dedicated to the purpose of a mechanics' institute.
