AN ACT to amend the Act to legalise the use of the Totalisator under certain circumstances.

[Assented to, 16th December, 1899.]

THEREAS it is expedient to define more clearly the meaning VV of "bona fide Club," as mentioned in the Totalisator Act, 1883: Be it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Western Australia and its Dependencies, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly thereof, as follows:—

Preamble.

- THIS Act may be cited as the Totalisator Act Amendment Short title. Act, 1899.
- 2. IT shall be lawful for the Colonial Treasurer to authorise any Club or Company, incorporated or otherwise, registered by the may authorise incor-Western Australian Turf Club, to have, use, and play with on the porated Club, etc., racecourse of such Club or Company the instrument known as the Totalisator, and such authority shall constitute such Club or Company a bona fide Club within the meaning of the Totalisator Act, 1883.

Colonial Treasurer to use Totalisator.
