AN ACT for the more speedy Trial of  
Accused Persons.

[Assented to, 9th October, 1899.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the law relating to  
Criminal Trials in the Supreme Court: Be it enacted by  
the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and  
consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of  
Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the  
authority of the same, as follows:—

Preamble.

1. THIS Act may be cited as the Supreme Court Criminal  
Sittings Act, 1899, and shall come into operation on the first day of  
the month following the month in which it is passed.

Short title and com-  
mencement.

2. AFTER the commencement of this Act, the Supreme Court  
Criminal Sittings at Perth shall be held monthly, except in the  
months of January and February.

Criminal sitting to be  
held in every month  
except January and  
February.

In the name and on behalf of the Queen I hereby assent  
to this Act.
