AN ACT to amend the Fire Brigades Act,
1898.

[Assented to, 16th December, 1899.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. SECTION eighteen of the Fire Brigades Act, 1898, is amended by striking out the words "Five thousand pounds," in the twelfth line thereof, and inserting "Ten thousand pounds" in lieu thereof.

to this Act.
